Very popular this week has been the amazing Mini tortilla muffins FS2 made to share with us all in snack.



Here is the recipe if you would like to try it at home;

To make in a muffin tin with 12 spaces, set oven to 180c fan/200c normal oven and use middle shelf

8 eggs – cracked and stir in a bowl

Savoury ingredients – grated cheese, ham, sweetcorn, red pepper (chopped) and slices of cooked carrots. A bowlful of each

Stir altogether with the eggs, butter the muffin trays and then ladle the mixture to fill the muffin tin (not quite to the top, leave room to grow) Cook for 15/20 mins until golden brown. Leave to cool before taking out of trays, ease out with a teaspoon. Enjoy they are yummy!

Polite reminders;

- Please can all children bring in a water bottle daily with water (not squash or juices – as part of school policy and DFE Healthy child initiative, we do have cups for snack times but as part of good drinking habits in warm climates we ensure children drink at regular intervals and having a water bottle at hand is a successful way to maintain this.
- Can all toys from home please stay at home, it supports families to reinforce a rule that toys stay at home and supports us to know the difference between a home toy or school. The only exception would be if a small comfort toy is required but they would remain in the child's bag or tray and only used to provide comfort if required.
